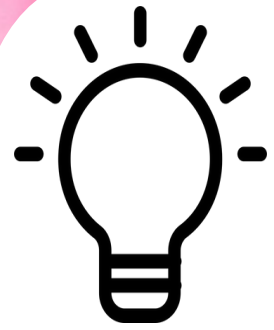

Structure



Ideally, your essay should contain 4 paragraphs:

Introduction: Explain in your own words what the graph(s), table(s), or diagram(s) is displaying

Overview: In general terms, tell what main/impressive features are.

Body 1/2: Explain these features in detail. If you have numbers, this is a good place to include them. Use two body paragraphs if you have two graphs/tables/diagrams

You are only required to write 150 words. You won't score extra marks for writing a longer essay. It's what you write that gains you marks. Having an essay structure to work with will help you with this. Aim for quality in your essay, not quantity – the right information written in a logical order.
