








# Comparative adjectives



### Short adjectives Long adjectives Irregular adjectives





Short adjectives

#### Structure: S + be + adj-er + than + Noun/Pronoun

#### **Example:** My brother is taller than you.





Long adjectives

## **Structure:** S + be + more/less adj + than + Noun/Pronoun

#### **Example:** Lan is more beautiful than her older sister.



## Irregular adjectives

## Structure: S + be + irregular adj + than + Noun/Pronoun

Adjectives	Comparative adjectives
bad	worse
good	better
many/much	more
little	less














## Short adjectives Long adjectives Irregular adjectives





Short adjectives

#### Structure: S + be + the + adj-est + Noun/Pronoun

#### **Example:** Minh is the tallest person in my class.





<u>Long adjectives</u>

#### Structure: S + be + the most/least + adj + Noun/Pronoun

#### **Example:** Van is the most intelligent girl in my class.





## Irregular adjectives

## Structure: S + be + the + irregular adj + Noun/Pronoun

Adjectives	Superlative adjectives
bad	the worst
good	the best
many/much	the most
little	the least









# Articles



# - We use **a**/an with a countable noun when we **first** mention it and **the** after that.

#### **Example:**

He is planning *a* wedding reception. He has invited 100 people to *the* wedding reception.



# We use **the** when it is clear in the situation which thing or person we mean.

#### Example:

The bride looks very happy.
