Responsibility (N)

/rəˌspänsəˈbilədē/



- the state or fact of having a duty to deal with something or of having control over someone.
- ex: She takes her responsibilities as a nurse very seriously.

gratitude (N)


/ˈgræţ.ə.tuːd/



- the feeling or quality of being grateful
- ex: Take this as a token of my gratitude for all your help..

Strengthen (v) '/stren.0an/





- to make something stronger or more effective, or to become stronger or more effective:
- ex: His words strengthened my resolve.

bond (n) /baind/



- a close connection joining two or more people
- ex: In societies with strong family bonds (= relationships), people tend to live longer.

character (n)

- the particular combination of qualities in a personor place that makes them different from others:
- ex: One of the joys of being a parent is watching the child's character develop..
