Short adjectives

Structure: S + be + adj-er + than + Noun/Pronoun

Example: My brother is taller than you.



Long adjectives

Structure: S + be + more/less adj + than +
Noun/Pronoun

Example:


Lan is more beautiful than
her older sister.

Structure: S + be + irregular adj + than + Noun/Pronoun

Short adjectives

Structure: S + be + the + adj-est + Noun/Pronoun

Example: Minh is the tallest person in my class.



Long adjectives

Structure: S + be + the most/least + adj + Noun/Pronoun

Example:

Van is the most intelligent girl
in my class.



Irregular adjectives

Structure: S + be + the + irregular adj + Noun/Pronoun

Adjectives	Superlative adjectives
bad	the worst
good	the best
many/much	the most
little	the least



Articles

A/An

- We use **a/an** with a countable noun when we **first** mention it and **the** after that.

Example:

He is planning **a** wedding reception.

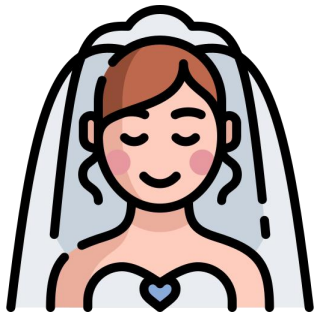
He has invited 100 people to **the** wedding reception.

The

- We use **the** when it is clear in the situation which thing or person we mean.

Example:

The bride looks very happy.
