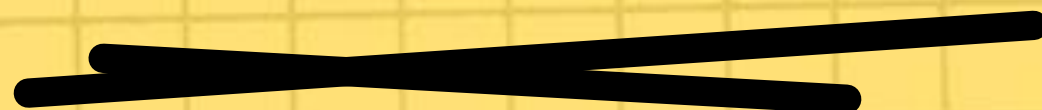

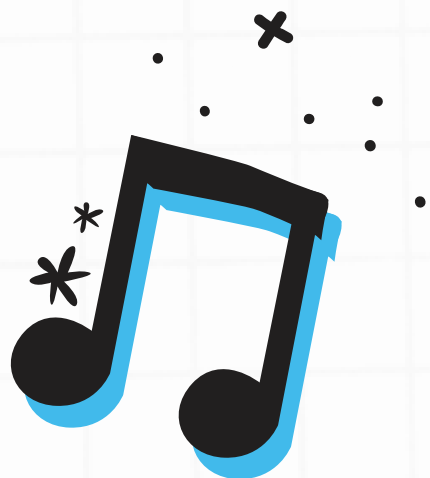
communicate (v) /kə'mju:nikeɪt/

exchange information by using writing, speaking, moving body, and signals.

→ **communication (n)**

→ **communicative (adj)**

E.g. Through the Internet, we can **communicate** with people on the other side of the world.

integral (adj) / 'intigrəl/

essential, very important

→ play an integral part

→ play an important part

→ be an integral part

E.g. Music plays an **integral** part
in many aspects of our live.

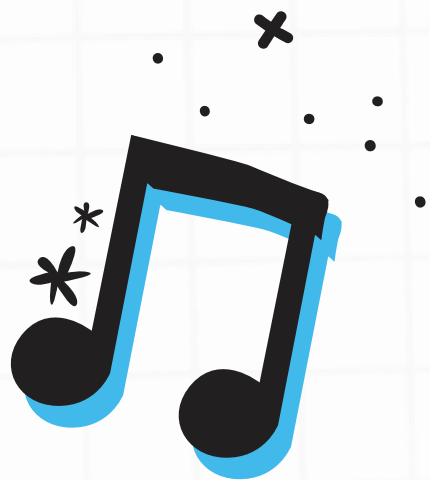
lull (v) /lʌl/

cause someone to feel that they want to sleep

→ lullaby (n)

→ lull sb to sleep

E.g. My grandma used to **lull** me to sleep every night when I was a little kid.

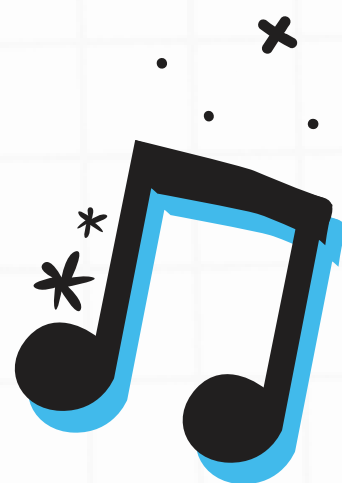
delight (n) /dɪ'laɪt/

a feeling of great pleasure, very joyful and glad

→ **delight (v)**

→ **delighted with (adj)**

E.g. Tom **was delighted with** the new headphone he received on his birthday.

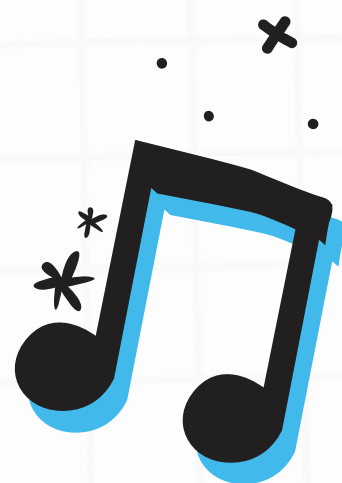
emotion (n) /ɪ'məʊʃn/

a strong feeling such as love, fear or anger; the part of a person's character including feelings

→ **emotional (adj)**

→ **emotionless (adj)**

E.g. My friend often has mixed **emotions** whenever she listens to that old song.

mournful (adj) / 'mɔ:nfl/

very sad or making you feel very sad

→ melancholy (syn)

→ mourn (v)

→ mourning (n)

E.g. Chopin's pieces of music for piano often express deep and **mournful** feelings.
