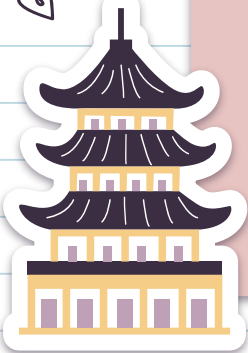

# Short adjectives

## Structure:

---

S + be + **adj - er** + **than** + Noun / Pronoun

Example: My sister is **shorter than** me.



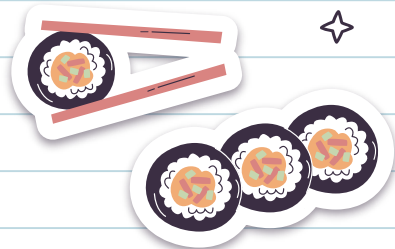
# Long adjectives

## Structure:

S + be + more/less + adj + than + Noun / Pronoun

Example: My sister is **more beautiful than** me.

$\Leftrightarrow$  I am **less beautiful than** my sister.

## Structure:



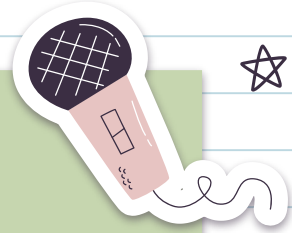
S + be + irregular adj + than + Noun / Pronoun

Adjectives	Comparative adjectives
bad	worse
good	better
many / much	more
little	less

# Short adjectives

## Structure:

S + be + the + adj - est + Noun / Pronoun

Example: My sister is the shortest person in her class.



# Long adjectives

## Structure:

---

S + be + **the most/ least + adj** + Noun / Pronoun

Example: My sister is **the most beautiful girl** in her class.





# Irregular adjectives

## Structure:



S + be + the + irregular adj + Noun / Pronoun

Adjectives	Superlative adjectives
bad	The worst
good	The best
many / much	The most
little	The least

# Articles





## A / An



- We use **a/an** with a countable noun when we **first** mention it and **the** after that.

Example:



\* He is planning **a** wedding reception.  
He has invited up to 200 guests to **the** wedding reception.





# The



- We use **the** when it is clear in the situation which thing or person we mean.

Example:



**The** bride looks very happy.
