UNIT 1: FAMILY LIFE

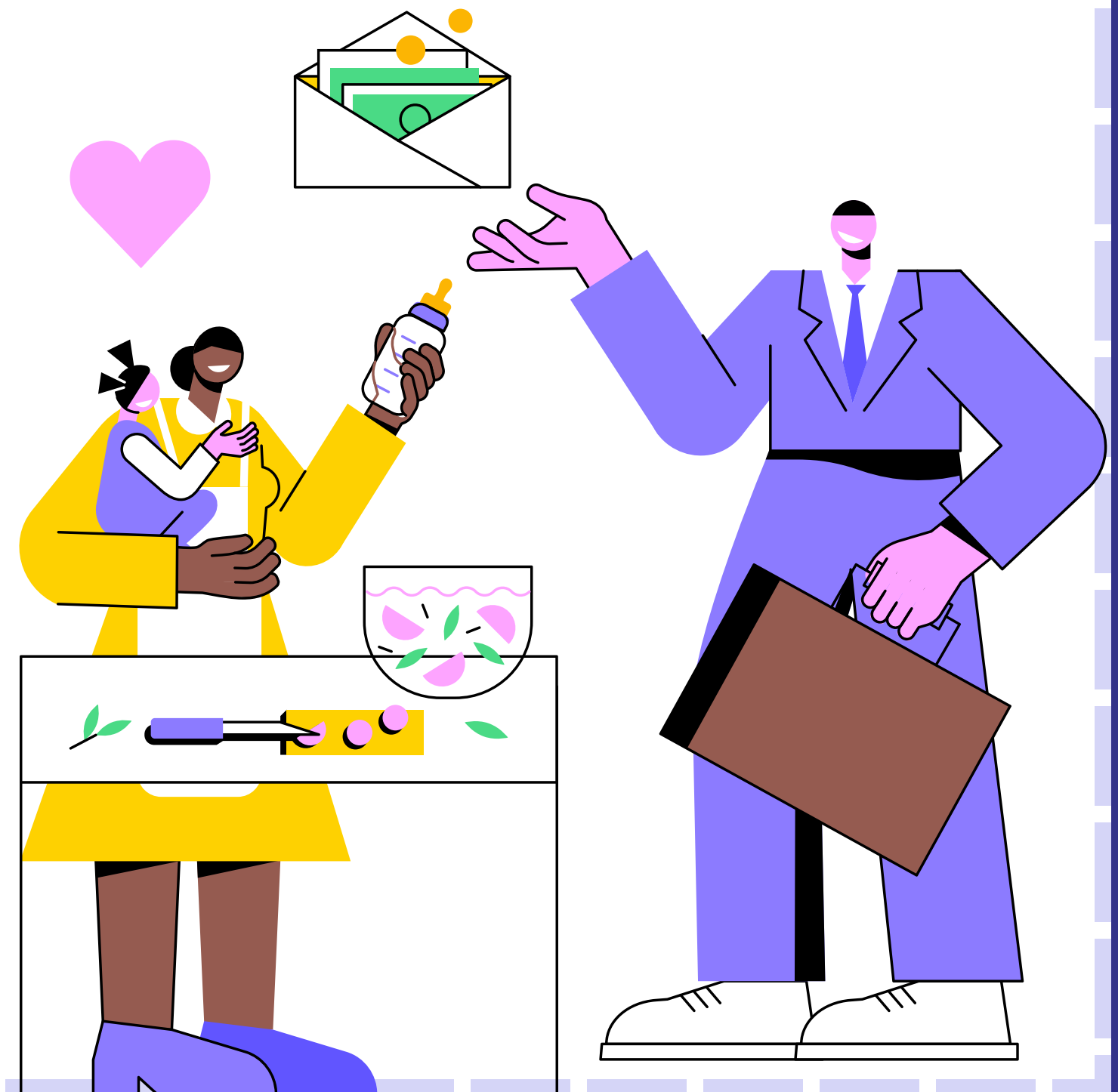


01 Breadwinner

/'bred,wɪnər/ (n)

a person who earns money to support a family.

Ex: Men are often expected to be the breadwinner in a family.



02 Housework

'hous,wɜ:k (n)

regular work done in housekeeping, such as cleaning, shopping, and cooking.

Ex: I was busy doing housework when the doorbell rang

Family word: houseworker (n)



03 Grocery

/'grōs(ə)rē/ (n)

food and other goods sold at a shop or a supermarket

Ex: I bought groceries for the family.

Family word: grocer (n)



04 Homemaker

/'hō(m),mākər/ (n)

work around the house such as cooking, cleaning or washing clothes

Ex: I was a homemaker with two small children



05 Heavy lifting

/'hev.i 'lift.ɪŋ/ (n)

picking up and carrying heavy objects.

Ex: Have it delivered from your local store or order online so you can skip the heavy lifting.
