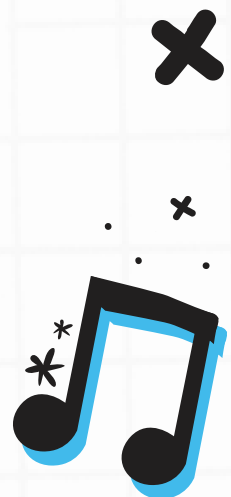

in order to

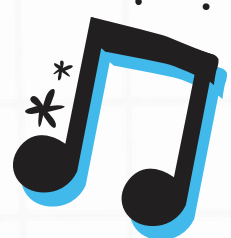
